An Extra Layer of Security

When you sign into MyCPG Accounts, you'll be prompted to enter an authorization code sent to you by your choice of text or a phone call. If further authentication is needed, you may be asked to answer additional questions.

A Stronger Form of Password

When you change your MyCPG Accounts password, it will need to contain at least 16 characters. This "passphrase" should be a unique, sentence-like string of words, spaces, characters, or symbols that is easy for you to remember. Phrases are more difficult to crack than a single word that substitutes numbers or symbols for letters. For example: "My favorite hymn is #473," or "Mark 1:4 is a very cool verse!"
