This voluntary, though crucial, initiative seeks to provide our Church with comprehensive insights regarding ordinations, deployment, and compensation.

To date, over 2,350 active clergy have responded to the call and updated their information in MyCPG Accounts.

We are now trying to gather responses from 500 more actively employed priests and bishops and your unique input will greatly enhance the accuracy and depth of our data.
