

Your Benefits Invoice Is Ready to View and Pay Online

Dear Friend:

Your benefit invoice has been posted to MyCPG Accounts. You should have received a separate email notification that your invoice is ready to view. As a reminder, CPG is no longer mailing paper invoices or accepting paper checks.

Active Member Annual Enrollment

- 1. Sign in to MyCPG Accounts (cpg.org/mycpg).
- 2. Select the "Benefits Bill Pay" button and use the dashboard to navigate to your billing statement and make a payment. That's it! (Viewing this visual step-by-step guide at <u>cpg.org/learning-billpay-individuals</u> can help you through the process.)

Please note: This is a new way to manage your CPG benefits invoices. We're sending this message to help you transition smoothly, **but we won't be** sending monthly reminders going forward. Please take action to avoid possible disruption of your benefits coverage.

Some banks have digital safeguards that may flag or restrict payments to new or unfamiliar vendors unless pre-authorized. To help ensure your bank does not block payments to the Church Pension Group through Paymentus, please follow your bank's instructions and share the following:
