Dear Friend:

Your benefit invoice has been posted to MyCPG Accounts. You should have received a separate email notification that your invoice is ready to view. As a reminder, **CPG is no longer mailing paper invoices or accepting paper checks.**

Active Member Annual Enrollment

- 1. Sign in to MyCPG Accounts (cpg.org/mycpg).
- 2. Select the “Benefits Bill Pay” button and use the dashboard to navigate to your billing statement and make a payment. That’s it! (Viewing this visual step-by-step guide at cpg.org/learning-billpay-individuals can help you through the process.)

Please note: This is a new way to manage your CPG benefits invoices. We’re sending this message to help you transition smoothly, **but we won’t be sending monthly reminders going forward.** Please take action to avoid possible disruption of your benefits coverage.

Institutions with Bank Pre-Authorization

Some banks have digital safeguards that may flag or restrict payments to new or unfamiliar vendors unless pre-authorized. To help ensure your bank does not block payments to the Church Pension Group through Paymentus, please follow your bank’s instructions and share the following:
