To ensure that your transition to Quantum is as seamless as possible, we're sending you this quick reminder of the main points to keep in mind.

You should have received a new medical ID card from ECMT with new member and group ID numbers. If you need immediate access to this card or want extra copies, call Quantum at 866-871-0629 or download a digital version via <a href="MyQuantumCare.org">MyQuantumCare.org</a>.

#### What You Need to Do

- Share your new card with your physicians, pharmacy, behavioral health providers, and other medical facilities.
  - o If your providers encounter a problem, ask them to call Quantum at the number listed on the back of your card, which is a **dedicated phone line** for ECMT members.
