Prior to this, she held editorial positions with John Wiley & Sons, Simon & Schuster, Warner Books, and Harper Collins. She was voted one of the top 50 women in publishing by *Book Business Magazine* in 2009.

She holds an MFA from Columbia University and a BA from Cornell University, and attended the MBA program at the Gabelli School of Business at Fordham University.
